Proclamation 2020P-101

By the Douglas County Board of County Commissioners

Declaring November 14-20, 2020 "Nevada Flood Awareness Month" in Douglas County, Nevada.

**WHEREAS**, Douglas County recognizes the significant threat flooding poses to residents, the County and our local economy, having endured repeated flood events from our watershed in the Carson River, Pinenut Creek, Buckeye Creek, Johnson Lane Wash, and Buckbrush Wash Watersheds, including the historic floods of 1955, 1997, 2006, 2014, 2015, and 2017.


**WHEREAS**, Douglas County is at particular risk of flooding, from slow rising riverine flooding in the winter and swift flash flooding in the summer.

**WHEREAS**, during Nevada Flood Awareness Week, local, state and federal agencies across the state are working together to inform the public about the dangers of flooding, how to protect their homes and families from a flood, and plan for recovery.


