

- Meet organization or regulatory requirements











Five Phases of the HSEEP Exercise Cycle

- Foundation: create a base of support (i.e., establish buy-in from the appropriate entities and/or senior officials); develop a project management timeline; identify an exercise planning team; and schedule planning conferences.
- 2. Design and Development: identifying objectives, designing the scenario, creating documentation, coordinating logistics, planning exercise conduct, evaluation and improvement methodology.




Five Phases of the HSEEP Exercise Cycle (cont.)

- 3. Conduct: setup, briefings, facilitation/control/evaluation, and wrap-up activities.
- 4. Evaluation: formal exercise evaluation, an integrated analysis, After Action Report/Improvement Plan (AAR/IP).
- 5. Improvement Planning: track identified corrective action to implementation; and then validated during subsequent exercises.



Design and Development – Select Exercise Type



- Determine scope

 - Facilitators, Recorders,
 Controllers, Evaluators
 - Participants/Players





Design and Development (cont.)

- Planning Meetings
 - Identify capabilities and objectives
 - Develop scenario and supporting documentation
 - Organize logistics
 - Virtual considerations
- Exercise Preparation Meetings
 - Facilitator, Recorder, Controller, Evaluator Training
 - Regional overview and site tour
 - Virtual training



- Implementation


